

Albertsons Companies' supplier Alexander & Hornung issues a recall on cooked ham due to possible *Listeria monocytogenes* contamination

Boise, ID, December 6, 2021 – Albertsons Companies (NYSE: ACI) announces removal of certain Open Nature Spiral Sliced Seasoned Uncured Ham in cooperation with the Alexander & Hornung recall. Listeria monocytogenes is an organism which can cause serious and sometimes fatal infections in young children, frail or elderly people, and others with weakened immune systems. Although healthy individuals may suffer only short-term symptoms such as high fever, severe headache, stiffness, nausea, abdominal pain and diarrhea, *Listeria* infection can cause miscarriages and stillbirths among pregnant women.

To date, there have not been any reports of *Listeria*-related illness reported to Alexander & Hornung or Albertsons Cos.
